FROM THE CHAIRMAN

By now all have heard about the deluge of executive orders, "requests," and memoranda that have been issued from the

White House. Eighteen were dispensed on Inauguration Day alone. Here are some of the most concerning and downright dangerous:

- Re-engaging with the World Health Organization – this is the group that has consistently issued “science based” proclamations – which are not – and covered for the Communist Chinese government’s unleashing of the virus
- Rejoining the Paris climate agreement – this is a dangerous continuation of bad policy and unconstitutional action – these “agreements” are actually treaties that should be confirmed by the Senate
- Revoking the permit for the Keystone XL pipeline, pausing new oil and gas leasing on US lands/water and declaring climate change as a national security and foreign policy priority – under President Trump we became energy independent with extremely low energy prices which benefitted every business and citizen
- Ending the 1776 Commission – this commission was trying to correct the recent re-writing of our history that had an emphasis on claiming our nation was founded by white people trying to enslave and exploit people of color
- Preserving DACA, stopping construction of the border wall and ending “harsh and extreme immigration enforcement” – all of these and the others that are sure to follow, are trying to ensure Democrat hegemony for the foreseeable future – if you cannot convince American citizens to vote your way, bring in new citizens who will

Your presence on APRIL 17 is critical, if you want to be a voting member for the new 2-year cycle!**

Our next regular monthly meeting will be Monday, **March 15, 2021** at 7:30 PM in the Winder Woman’s Club. Our guest speaker will be our 10th U.S. District Congressman Jody Hice. Tables will not be set up; chairs will be spread out across the hall for distancing. Hand sanitizer will be available as you come in either door. There will be no refreshments. WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE 2021 PRECINCT CAUCUSES AND COUNTY CONVENTION

Many of our newer members may not be aware of the significance of our upcoming Precinct Caucuses and County Convention set for Saturday, **April 17, 2021**, at the Winder Lions Club, 354 E. Broad St., Winder. The following is information to explain what will be happening on this important date.

Temporary Precinct Caucus Chairpersons will be appointed by the current Barrow GOP Chairman Debbie Reid. At 9:00 AM on **April 17**, these people will call the 8 individual precinct caucus meetings to order. All participants at these meetings must be duly registered in accordance with State Republican Party rules and Georgia State Election Code. The first order of precinct meeting business is to elect new Precinct Chairpersons for 2021-2023 (and other Precinct officers, if desired by the precinct participants). The new Precinct Chairperson will conduct the rest of the meeting. Each precinct meeting will then elect Delegates and Alternates to the 2021 Barrow County Republican Convention. All Delegates will receive name tags for Convention usage.

When all of the elections are completed, the paperwork (in triplicate) will be processed and routed to the appropriate local Party representatives. Other precinct business may take place at this meeting. It will be a good time to get acquainted with other Republicans in your precinct, and plans for future precinct work can be discussed.

At 10:00 AM on **April 17, 2021**, the current local Party Chairman Debbie Reid (serving as Temporary Convention Chairman) will call the 2021 County Convention to order. After the Pledge of Allegiance, Invocation, Presentation of the state call, and Introduction of Elected Officials, the convention will elect the 2021 Permanent Convention Chairperson and Permanent Convention Secretary. Convention committees will then be dismissed to conduct their work (Credentials, Nominations, Rules). During this time, there may be announcements and speeches in the convention hall.

After the Convention committees return and report, the 2021-2023 Barrow County Republican officers will be elected. These include County Chairperson, First Vice-Chairperson, Second Vice-Chairperson, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, and Assistant Treasurer. The Convention will then elect Delegates and Alternates to the 10th U.S. Congressional District Republican Convention to be held on Saturday, **May 15, 2021**, at a location to be announced. Delegates and Alternates will also be elected to the State Republican Convention to be held on Friday and Saturday, **June 4-5, 2021**, at a location to be announced. Those who qualify and desire will also form the new County Committee (voting members) for 2021-2023.

Your participation in the 2021 Precinct Caucuses will strengthen the Barrow County Republican Party. With your help, we have made a major impact. The next election cycle has begun

THE DIVIDED FASCIST STATES OF AMERICA

Do you believe that you live in the United States of America? You have been deceived all of your life. No one alive today has ever lived in the USA. Right now, perhaps you have thought

that I have finally lost my mind. (That may be debatable.) I don't think so for a moment. Please let me explain.

The United States of America ended in December 1860.

On the day South Carolina left the Union, followed by 10 other southern states, the United States of America came to an end. If we were to use the French designation of their republics, then the First American Republic died at the end of 1860. Whether you call it the Civil War, the Southern Rebellion, or War of Northern Aggression, for whatever reasons, a war between American brothers took place. The South lost.

What emerged in 1865 was the Second American Republic.

The federal government, by right of victory, emerged more powerful than before. The question of leaving the union was settled in blood. Southern slavery was rightfully ended. Federal troops stayed in the South for years during the "Reconstruction" of former Confederate states. Unfortunately, backlash to that set the South back for a hundred years, and ushered in the evil Jim Crow laws, legal separation of the races (*Plessy v. Ferguson*), and Democratic Party/KKK dominance in the South.

During this Second Republic, the reunited nation experienced the Great Westward Migration, transcontinental railroads, and the Industrial Revolution. It also saw the beginnings of unwise military foreign involvement (Spanish-American War, for example) which would lead to participation in the wars of the 20th century. Always hanging around as a natural force, the forces of urbanization, socialism, and progressivism began to gain strength in the late 19th century.

Strangely, the Second American Republic came to an end in 1913. Hardly anyone knew it. This change was not as violent as the end of the First Republic. In fact, the people supported and voted for the change. Looking back, the **Third American Republic** was the goal of progressivism, to lead the country away from the early founding principles of freedom, liberty, and individual responsibility. It would be a Socialist or Fascist Republic. Three major events took place in 1913 which forever changed the "USA" of the Second Republic.

(1) The 16th Amendment to the federal constitution was passed. The federal government could now levy an income tax.

(2) The 17th Amendment to the federal constitution was passed. Instead of state legislatures choosing their state's U.S. Senators, this choice was handed to the people as a popular vote.

(3) The Federal Reserve Act of 1913 was passed. The big bankers grew tired of the current financial system, and wanted to maintain control. They met at Jekyll Island, Georgia, drew up the plan which passed Congress, under the pretense of bringing order to the system. Unelected, unaccountable people were given power unimaginable to the Founding Fathers, many of whom opposed a central bank.

The seeds of liberalism, progressivism, fascism, socialism were firmly planted for what started out as a long slow trek to communism. I really don't care what you call it in a sense. It is not what the First or Second Republics were about. No longer did people care to ask, "Is this the proper role of government, according to the Constitution?" Sure, said the liberal Supreme Court. God forbid that we stand in the way of progress. How about the New Deal, designed to increase dependence on the federal government? How about the United Nations, with seeds of globalism? Social Security? Medicare? Abortion? The so-called "sovereign states" became provinces subservient to the federal overlords.

When President John F. Kennedy was assassinated in Dallas, Texas on November 22, 1963, radicals in the Demo-

cratic Party became determined to take power and keep it forever. The public educational system was hijacked by radical socialists to sway the children. The 1960s sexual revolution, the anti-war movement, anti-establishmentarianism (until they became the Establishment of today, the Deep State?), and big government has all the answers to our problems.

We would expect the leadership of the Republican Party to fight back against all of this. Turns out that there were few exceptions to the general rule, like Goldwater, Reagan, Gingrich, and Trump. The failure of RINOs (Republicans-In-Name-Only) to push back during the past decades is a major reason we are where we are today!

When George W. Bush was elected in 2000, the Left ramped up their attacks, hatred, and lies, leading to a truly evil man, Barack Hussein Obama as President in 2008. Obamacare, open borders, voting fraud, the rise of China, bowing to Saudis, "America's best days are over. We must manage the decline, because the USA was an evil racist creation (as opposed to a perfect socialist utopia - KY)."
